CTS COURSES

- A typical CTS course is taught over 12 weeks at a frequency of one class a week **OR** over 4 full days ('modular' course)
- 2-credit courses: a total of 24 classroom hours
 - 3-credit courses: 24 classroom hours + practical work amounting to 12 hours

PRACTICUM

This component includes, in the early stages, practice of face-to-face counselling in class and other counselling-related skills; and at the final stage, a minimum number of face-to-face counselling hours, and regular supervision.
