The CTS Scholarship Scheme

The CTS Scholarship Scheme exists to provide assistance with tuition fees to students who have been accepted onto a programme of study (i.e. CCS, ACC, Diploma, BTh, MA/PGDip) and are facing difficulties in meeting the full cost of tuition. **Important:** The 'full cost of tuition' refers to the highly subsidised rate that CTS is able to offer because of the generous gifts of the friends-of-the-ministry.

Note: The funds for each scholarship grant are raised by CTS from individuals, churches, and foundations. In principle, the CTS Scholarship Scheme anticipates that you (and your family and friends) as well as your sending church/organisation will work together in attempting to meet a significant percentage of the cost of your education ('Student Annual Fee').

How does the CTS Scholarship Scheme work?

- Scholarships are granted for one year at a time.
- You will need to submit a completed application on time to be considered for a scholarship grant.
- You have the option of paying your annual fee in total at the beginning of the year *or* in three instalments by 31st August of the current year.

How to apply for a CTS Scholarship:

Step 1: Submit an application through [Scholarship Application](#) or collect an application form and had in to Student Accounts by the date noted on the form. **INCOMPLETE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.**

Please note: The application must be completed in ENGLISH.

Step 2: Once you have been informed of your scholarship grant, collect your STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP CARD from the Resource Development Office.

Please note: You will need to produce this STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP CARD to Student Accounts when making payments.

NOTE: Any application handed in after the deadline stated on the application form will include a surcharge of 25% of the Annual Fee.

A CTS Scholarship Recipient's Responsibilities:

CTS raises the funds for your scholarship through the generous gifts of friends of the ministry. These individuals, churches, and organisations also pray for you. You are expected to be good stewards of the investment being made in you by committing yourself to your studies, being actively involved in the community life of CTS, and praying for those who make it possible for CTS to grant you a scholarship. An important aspect of good stewardship is to report how a donor's financial investment is being used – you will be required to provide updates on your studies and ministry so that CTS could report regularly to those who are helping to support you in your studies.
